Key messages on the SGSecure had also been incorporated in this third edition of the training cum dialogue session, organised by the NFEC Commercial Premises Committee (CPC). At the session, Chairperson of CPC, Ms Margaret Heng delivered the opening address to thank all participants for their attendance and highlighted the event objectives - to share fire safety and SGSecure messages.

During the dialogue, MAJ Lim Lam Kwang and LTA Lim Yew Yee from SCDF presented key findings from fire safety inspections and fire analysis researches on kitchen exhaust system (KES) fires in eating establishments. They also highlighted fire prevention tips and good fire safety practices.
