A Dialogue Session with the Fire Safety Managers (FSMs) of shopping complexes organised by Commercial Premises Committees was held at Shaw Centre on the afternoon of 30 June 2016. Approximately 40 FSMs from various major shopping complexes were represented at the Session.

In this Dialogue, MAJ Rashid Bin Mohd Noor from SCDF presented on the fire statistics relating to shopping complexes and shared interesting insights to a fire incident that occurred at Golden Mile Shopping Complex. CPT Kang Kim Long from SCDF also presented on enforcement statistics and common fire safety non-compliances observed at shopping complexes.

At the end of the presentations, LTC Winson Cheung and the presenters also took questions from the participants.

The Dialogue was a very meaningful and fruitful session where the participants exchanged their views and were reminded of the pivotal role they play in maintaining good fire safety in shopping complexes.
