A Prevention of Air Conditioning Fire Workshop for the air conditioning industry, organised by Commercial and Industrial Premises Committees, was held at First SCDF Division HQ on the afternoon of 31 March 2016. Approximately 70 participants consisting of air conditioning manufacturers, installers, distributors and facilities engineers attended the session.

In this workshop, CPT Soh Seok Yuen from SCDF gave a presentation on the fire statistics relating to air conditioning fires and a study on fires involving the air conditioning fan coil unit. CPT Yazeed Abdul Rahman from SCDF shared on case studies and fire causes of air conditioning fires.

At the end of the presentations, LTC Lim Beng Hui, Commander Fire Research Unit *concurrent* Fire Investigation Unit and the presenters also took questions from the participants relating to air conditioning fires.

The workshop was a very meaningful and fruitful session where the participants shared their views and was reminded of the pivotal role they play in preventing air conditioning fires.
